If you would like to play football for Island Bay this year please register online at www.ibuafc.wellington.net.nz or download a registration form from the website and send with payment to the address listed below. Please note that a separate registration form is required for each individual player. **(Registrations close 28 Feb 2010)**

A \$10.00 non-refundable administration fee is included in the registration, and there will be no refunds after 1st April.

Fees for 2010 have been increased due to increased levies from Capital and NZ Football.
The registration fees for the 2009 season are listed below

One child (8-13th grade) - \$90.00

Grading

All junior players are graded according to their age as at 31 Dec 2010.
ie; If you are born in 2003 or later you will be in the 7th grade Player Development Programme (PDP),
2002 = 8th grade, 2001 = 9th grade, 2000 = 10th grade, 1999 = 11th grade, 1998 = 12th grade, 1997 = 13th grade.

Girls may play down one age group. eg; born 1997 = 12th grade but may **choose** to play 11th grade.
Girls please ensure that you enter the grade that **you want to play in** the 2010 season on your registration form.

Island Bay Uniform – Correct uniform must be worn for all players

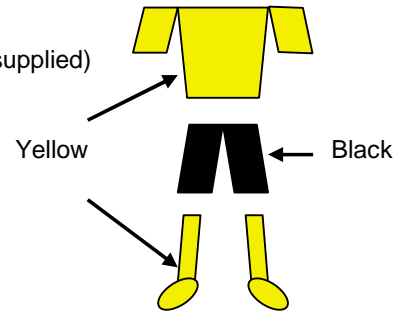
Plain Black shorts, Yellow socks, Shinpads and Football boots. (The team shirt is supplied)
